SP Act s. 9	Does your security firm have a licence? For example: Class 1 Security Firm (SF1)—hire crowd controllers. Class 2 Security Firm (SF2)—security advisor, security equipment installer. Visit qld.gov.au/fairtrading for more information.		
	Are all the security providers engaged by your firm appropriately licensed? You can check a licence here.		
	Do you have processes in place to ensure that their licences are current? Information on renewing your licence can be found here.

SP Regs s. 10	Does your security firm's business name match the name on your licence? If no, you are required to update your security details.

SP Regs s. 21	Does your security firm have a crowd control register?
